Just How Long is a Cable Tow?

“The length of a cable tow is “reasonable ability.” The phrase was adopted at the Baltimore Masonic Convention of 1848, to define how far a cable tow stretched. In older days a cable tow was as long as an hour’s journey, roughly three miles. Today a brother must answer a summons if within “the scope of his reasonable ability.” In modern words, a cable tow is such length as to satisfy the individual brothers conscience.”
